He's currently at work on a graphic novel called "The Book of Lamps" and a documentary project entitled "Found Poem Including History, an Essay on the Epic." He grew up in Virginia.

Ana Božičević is the author of Stars of the Night Commute (Tarpaulin Sky, 2009) and Rise in the Fall (Birds, LLC, 2013), named one of the top five poetry books of 2013 by Publishers Weekly. She studies poetics and teaches at the CUNY Graduate Center, works at VanessaPlace Inc., and makes poetry films. With Sophia Le Fraga, she performs as not I.

Thomas Heise is the author of three books: Moth; or how I came to be with you again (Sarabande, 2013), Horror Vacui: Poems (Sarabande, 2006), and Urban Underworlds: A Geography of Twentieth-Century American Literature and Culture (Rutgers University Press, 2011). His work has been anthologized in Legitimate Dangers: American Poets of the New Century and will be included in the forthcoming collection The Americas Anthology of New Writings: From Patagonia to Nunavut. An assistant professor at McGill University, he divides his time between Montreal and Brooklyn.
