Emmalea Russo is a Brooklyn-based artist and writer. She is the Managing Editor at Ugly Duckling Presse (UDP) and the author of *they* (Gauss PDF, 2014), *CLEARING* (Dancing Girl Press, 2014), and *book of southern and water* (Poor Claudia, 2013).

Karen Weiser is the author of *Or*, *The Ambiguities* (UDP, 2015), *To Light Out* (UDP, 2010), *Dear Pierre* (Well Greased Press, 2012), *Placefullness* (UDP, 2004), and *Pitching Woo* (Cy Press, 2006). Residencies include Robert Rauschenberg Foundation and Process Space, through the Lower Manhattan Cultural Council, and a New York Foundation of the Arts Fellowship in Poetry. She lives in New York City where she teaches and writes on 19th century American Literature.

Jeff Kurosaki and Tara Pelletier are a collaborative duo based in the Hudson Valley, New York who build multi-layered narrative projects using sculpture, video, music, and performance. They have exhibited and performed internationally and at Vox Populi (PA), Wave Hill Gardens (NY), Palisades (NY), Cake Shop (NY) and Present Company (NY). They recently released *Passing Showers*, an EP with their band REAL THINGS.
